

Home Group Facilitators

Join the team! Help us create welcoming, dynamic, and grounded spaces for Friends to connect and share during Sessions this summer.

Throughout Sessions, *Home Groups* offer Friends a space to practice the core of our faith: worshiping, discerning, and witnessing in community, together. While we cannot be physically together, spiritually and socially we will be together to renew our spirits and listen for how God is calling us.

Home Groups are groups of 8–12 people that meet for spiritual conversation, connection, and community building. Friends are seen, known, and held. Home Groups support Friends sharing and processing of their experiences of Sessions and what is moving in their own spiritual lives. Home Groups will meet virtually and include Friends from across NEYM and visitors to NEYM Sessions. **We are seeking facilitators for these small Home Groups during Sessions.**

We are seeking interest from facilitators (and co-facilitators) at all levels of availability and experience. Home Groups meet for 75 minutes at the same time each day and will be offered at various times throughout the day to accommodate different schedules. Friends can register for the level of commitment that works with their lives and schedules: meeting each day, meeting every other day, or a daily drop-in group.

We will provide training for all facilitators on how to safely hold inclusive space for groups and individuals over Zoom. We will provide all facilitators with a detailed, daily plan for the Home Groups and the flexibility for each facilitator to bring their own gifts and respond to their group's specific dynamics. Training will be provided over multiple time options in the second half of July and early August.
