Report of the Israel Palestine Resource Group of NEYM (under the care of the Permanent Board) September 21, 2024

The I-PRG meets monthly to review and propose programs and to provide support for individuals, meetings and other Quaker groups looking for resources and consultation. We offered a workshop at Living Faith and several at annual sessions, featuring Jennifer Bing of AFSC's Palestine Program and Alex MacDonald of Houston Friends Meeting on how to engage with supporters of Israel about the situation in Palestine. We also worked closely with the FUM Committee and Quakers Advocating Justice for Palestine in co-sponsoring several "lunch and learns" and a workshop with Head of Ramallah Friends School, Rania Mayeeh.

We have received inquiries from several meetings about follow up to these workshops; and we rely on the weekly updates from AFSC on Fridays at 12 noon Eastern for reliable information and suggestions for action.
