

Arriving at Castleton

Check-in will take place in the **Fine Arts Center Lobby**, however **there are set hours for each day during which check-in is available**. You must check in to use your registration meal plan, access housing, or participate in most programs.

Registration hours:

- **Friday:** 5–7 p.m.; 8:30–10 p.m. The dining hall will be open from 6:00–7:30 p.m.
- **Saturday:** 9 a.m.–2:30 p.m.; 4:30–6:00 p.m.; 8:30–10 p.m.
- **Sunday:** 8:15–9 a.m.; 12:15–1:15 p.m., 4:30–5:30 p.m.; 7–9 p.m.
- **Monday–Wednesday:** 9:30–10:30 a.m., 4:30–5 p.m.

For registration needs outside these hours, please contact the Registrar well in advance at registrar@neym.org or 978-494-6396 to make alternate arrangements.

Late evening arrivals: Please plan ahead and make arrangements with the Registrar. Staff cannot accommodate arrivals after posted hours. You may ask someone already on campus to pick up and hold your key, if your registration is already paid in full.

Fees: The balance of your registration fees will be due upon check-in. Contact Martha Sheldon, Registrar (registrar@neym.org; 978-494-6396), to change or cancel your registration. DO NOT mail anything to the Registrar at this time.

Youth Forms: If you have not yet submitted all required youth forms (health information and parental consent), these will also need to be presented at the time of check-in.

Friday arrivals: Registration hours on Friday are 5–7 p.m.; 8:30–10 p.m. Your fees include Friday dinner and Saturday breakfast and lunch. The dining hall will be open from 6:00–7:30 p.m.

Saturday arrivals: Please plan to arrive before 2:00 or after 4:00. Registration hours on Saturday are 9 a.m.–2:30 p.m.; 4:30–6:00 p.m.; 8:30–10 p.m.

Due to the Shriners Parade on Main Street in Castleton, access to campus will be difficult for a few hours. We advise all Friends to **arrive before 2 p.m. or after 4 p.m.** to avoid getting stuck in heavy traffic or stranded on the edge of town.
